2. ACCOMMODATIONS & MEALS

➤ Application for On-Campus Housing

Exchange students can choose either on-campus or off-campus housing. Although Hanyang International Office provides assistance in seeking off-campus housing, on-campus housing is highly recommended because housing in Seoul is very expensive and hard to find short-term housing. If on-campus housing is desired, students should indicate in the application form and make **a full payment by February 10, 2012 under the student name only**. Late payment will not be accepted and result in failure of dorm assignment.

※ When the payment cannot be made in the Korean currency, please transfer the fee either US dollars or Euro based on the exchange rate. Disparity in the total amount shall be refunded or repaid after arrival.

➤ Regulation

Those who wish to remain in the dormitory are required to abide by dormitory regulations. Under no circumstances is cooking permitted in the dormitory rooms. No guests are allowed in the dormitory and no visitation is allowed between the men's and women's floors. Neither smoking nor drinking is permitted in the dormitory building.

➤ Meals

Please note that the total fee of the program does not include meals, so students are responsible for purchasing their own meals. Students can have meals at various student cafeterias on campus or at nearby restaurants both on and off campus. The cafeteria in the dormitory offers three meals a day, all of which are affordably priced. On the Orientation Day, students will be informed about the location of some of the eateries on and off campus. International students are encouraged to get together with Hanyang University students to sample various the cafeterias and restaurants in and around campus. Restaurants that cater to vegetarians however, are not easy to find. Although non-meat dishes abound, it may be difficult to find a place specializing in exclusively vegetarian dishes.

3. INSURANCE

According to the regulations of Korean Ministry of Education and Hanyang University, all exchange students are required to buy International Student Insurance. All exchange students have to submit a proof of insurance by email before their arrival in Korea. If not, all exchange students are required

to purchase insurance through a designated agency by Hanyang University on the Orientation Day and will cost approximately 180,000 ~250,000 KRW for one semester.

4. ARRIVAL

➤ By Bus

A convenient Airport Limousine Bus can be taken from the airport to Hanyang University. The fare is 13,000 Won and you can take the bus at the bus stop marked "3B" or "10A" at the Incheon International Airport, heading for Do-Bong. The bus runs every 20 to 40 minutes, from 06:10 to 22:00, and costs about 13,000 won. After 60 to 90 minute-rides, you should get off at SeongDong-Gu Office. Across the SeongDong-Gu Office, you can take taxi to Hanyang University Student Residence Hall No.2 and it will take only 5 minutes.



➤ Pick-Up Service

Hanyang offers an airport pick-up service to the university. The fee for this door-to-door service is 70,000KRW. When arriving in groups, students can share the fee. Students have to pay the fee in cash directly to the driver. Taxi driver is not good at English or other languages, so if you have a difficulty in communicating, please call the office at +82-(0)2-2220-0045.

5. MENTORING PROGRAM

Exchange students can apply for the Mentoring Program which is very strongly recommended. Mentors are Hanyang regular students and help exchange students for smooth settlement and adjustment into the life and culture of the visiting country. Upon the arrival, exchange students will be provided with full assistance, support, and useful information from mentors.

-Mentor Assistance: Course selection, student card issuance, campus tour, university festivals, local events ,insurance, health concerns, visa issues, alien registration, language tutoring/exchange etc.

-Student Card: Students will be given Hanyang Student Card during the Welcome Orientation.
