



NEW INTERNATIONAL POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE SCIENCES

The Faculty of Science at the University of Sydney takes great pleasure in announcing The Dean's International Postgraduate Research Scholarships for new international postgraduate research students.

DESCRIPTION

The Faculty of Science is offering a limited number of these prestigious scholarships aimed at attracting high achieving, academically meritorious, international students to enjoy the Sydney Science experience at one of the finest institutions of higher education in the world. Applications are assessed on academic merit and research potential. Students must have completed the third year of a current four year undergraduate degree in science or related discipline (see Eligibility Requirements for further details).

The Dean's International Postgraduate Research Scholarships are available to students commencing in 2013.

AMOUNT AWARDED

The scholarship consists of the full cost of academic tuition fees plus a stipend equivalent to an Australian Postgraduate Award indexed annually (in 2011 the APA rate was \$22,860 per annum), and is awarded for three years, subject to satisfactory progress, with a possible extension of a maximum of one year.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must (please check the website for full details):

- Have completed the third year of a four year Bachelors Degree in Science at an approved international university, in a degree program that includes an independent research project;

- Have completed three years of a Bachelors Degree in Science with a GPA greater than 85 or an average A grade, or have a relevant subject specific GPA of 90, or equivalent;

- May not be a citizen or hold permanent residency in Australia or New Zealand
- Be commencing postgraduate study at the University for the first time
- Not be in receipt of any other tuition fee scholarship

- Successfully complete their 4th year of your current Bachelors Degree in Science meeting the academic requirements of the scholarship and complete in time to commence studies at the University of Sydney in Semester 2 2013.

Applications for admission to the PhD program with accompanying personal statement and relevant documentation must be received by no later than **30 October 2012.** Please contact us to for more details.
